YFCC iParty for Year

On Thursday 18 September, Year 10 students will be participating in the YFCC iParty Program. iParty is a safe partying program covering legal and illegal drugs, emergency response, relationships, sexting, and safe sex.

Youth Family and Community Connections (YFCC) have been delivering drug, alcohol and health promotions programs in schools across the North-West and West Coasts for many years.

Workshops are aimed to be educational, interactive and delivered within a harm minimisation and early intervention framework. Facilitators are suitably qualified, experienced and undertake ongoing training in relevant subject areas. They can also provide links and referrals to other support services relevant to young people and are happy to discuss issues or topics with school staff.

At the conclusion of each workshop students are invited to complete an evaluation which iParty use to consistently improve their programs and ensure they are both enjoyable and educational.
